For Warren Yazoo Behavioral Health, like many other helping organizations, it has been a challenging year for staff who were on the frontline, facing a shifting situation and seeing an increase in acute symptoms of clients. As the most comprehensive provider of behavioral health services in Warren and Yazoo counties, especially low-income and indigent adults, Warren Yazoo Behavioral Health served a total of 3,015 consumers in 2021.

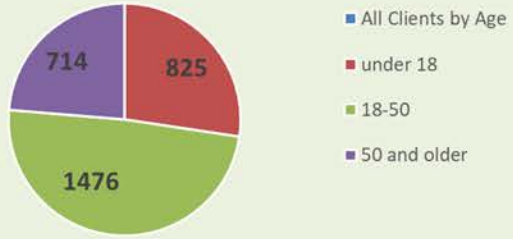
